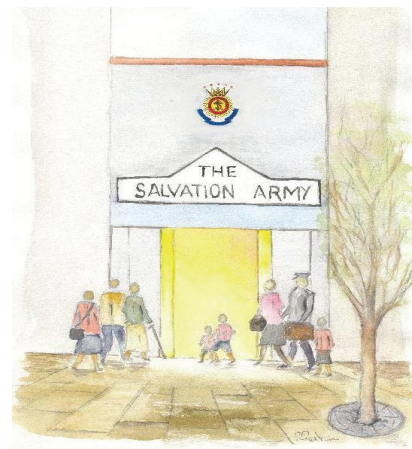

Thank you to Colin & Nicola for their preparation and leadership of Worship, week by week. I have particularly enjoyed the last two Sunday mornings, both by the challenge of their words but also by the supporting music which has enhanced our worship. Sometimes I think we take for granted the blessings God gives us through our musicians. But worship is not just about challenge and enjoyment, it's about being personal, from me to God.

Philip Smith is a legend among trumpet players. As a Salvationist, he maintained a high reputation amongst trumpeters worldwide as one of the best. He assumed the co-principal position in the New York Philharmonic



Orchestra in June 1978 and then principal trumpet in 1988 until his retirement in 2014. He is now the Professor of Trumpet at the University of Georgia. I heard Philip play as a soloist many years ago when his Corps band were in the UK – I still remember his flawless & effortless playing all these years on.

Philip is quoted as saying "*Music is not just the black dots on the white paper it's what happens when those black dots on the white paper go into your heart and come out again*".

That should be true of all our worship whether actions, spoken word, music or silence. No matter what Colin or Nicola prepares or the Band plays or the Songsters sing or the young people do, it's what comes out from our hearts.
