# Sunday 23rd April 2017

Anniversaries are an important part of life. They remind us of important events. Whether we're marking a birthday, a wedding, a momentous event, or the death of a loved one, an anniversary puts a pin on the calendar to remind us of something that matters to us. It's a chance to reflect on a relationship, to come together to remember a person who's died, or to celebrate a joyous event. Whatever the anniversary, it gives us a chance to look back over the years since the event we're marking, and reflect on how it has shaped us. Remembering the past but without letting it rule us, can be an important part of understanding who we are. Anniversaries often elicit mixed emotions – doing something amazing to mark the date, perhaps setting some goals for the year ahead. And of course, it's great to enjoy the big day with flowers, parties and presents. But anniversaries aren't always about celebration. We will have days when we remember a friend or family member who's died – friends will pick up the phone, or send a message so that people know they're not alone in thinking of that person.

In Deuteronomy 16, God commanded Israel to "observe the month," to "remember the day," and even to offer their sacrifice "at the time of day" when they left Egypt. The exodus was the event that defined Israel's identity as God's people, and God knew how important it was for them to commemorate that defining moment. They needed to always remember what God had done for them and who they were as God's people. And how were they to "remember" such a significant occasion? By throwing a party! "You shall rejoice before the LORD your God, you and your son and your daughter..."

Today, we as a fellowship remember how much God has done for us and that we are His people as well as remembering loved ones, birthdays & weddings!
