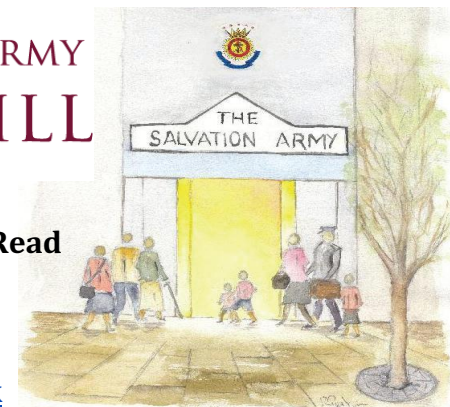

How we Reach Out to share Jesus takes many forms. We have many activities inside our suite of buildings that Reach Out & share Jesus as well as outside at Page Park Praise & collecting at Morrison's. But one of the unsung, perhaps old-fashioned methods of outreach & sharing Jesus is through the Literature Ministry, selling the War Cry in Public Houses on a Friday evening – Pub Booming. David James has loyally done this over the last 50 years and has been joined by Marion Richardson. Here are her musings of a Friday evening:

"Each Friday evening, 'The War Cry' and 'Kids Alive' are taken by our Literature Ministries team to 6 pubs and 2 clubs. We start at The Globe in Frampton Cotterell and finish at The Red Lion in Mangotsfield (with Coalpit Heath and Pucklechurch in between!) Over the course of many years we have built up excellent relationships, with many regulars buying papers weekly, and others not wanting a paper but generously putting a donation in our boxes. Obviously, the money we collect is much appreciated and gratefully received, but we believe that first and foremost we are a means of outreach. We are a Christian presence, and by 'just being there' we can make a difference. Having the time to listen and come alongside someone who wants to talk is very important and shows that we care. We are shown so much warmth and respect as we go around, and have been trusted to share in some extremely difficult situations as well as many happy and exciting times. We are treated as friends, and this is very special to us. Sometimes it is a real effort to turn out in the cold, wet or dark evenings, but as soon as we reach The Globe we are re-energised and ready to go. This is most certainly a rewarding and fulfilling, if tiring, ministry".

We thank Marion, David & Gary White who stands in for David when he is away. More importantly we pray for the spiritual success of their ministry.
