

The Weekly Bulletin for Sunday 10th June 2018

Last Sunday morning, Colin preached to us from 1 Thessalonians 2 showing us exactly how we can Reaching Out to Share Jesus at Page Park today:

BE BOLD: (vs 2) We had previously *suffered* and been treated *outrageously* in Philippi, as you know, but with the help of our God we dared to tell you his gospel in the face of *strong opposition*.

BE TRUE: (vs 3) For the appeal we make does *not spring from error or impure motives, nor are we trying to trick you*.

BE HONEST: (vs 4-6) On the contrary, we speak as those approved by **God to be entrusted** with the gospel. We are not trying to please people but God, who tests our hearts. You know *we never used flattery, nor did we put on a mask to cover up greed* – God is our witness. We were *not looking for praise* from people, not from you or anyone else, even though as apostles of Christ we could have asserted our authority.

BE COMMITTED: (vs 7-9) Instead, we were like young children among you. Just as a nursing mother cares for her children, so *we cared for you*. Because we loved you so much, we were delighted to *share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well*. Surely you remember, brothers and sisters, our *toil & hardship; we worked night & day* in order not to be a burden to anyone while we preached the gospel of God to you.

BE HOLY: (vs 10) You are witnesses, and so is God, of how *holy, righteous and blameless* we were among you who believed.

I look forward to seeing you at Page Park tomorrow being bold, true, honest, committed & holy as you play, sing, speak & face paint God's love.
