Brenda Cook remains in Intensive Care. The situation is very serious. Brenda, Paul & the family are surrounded by our love & prayers.

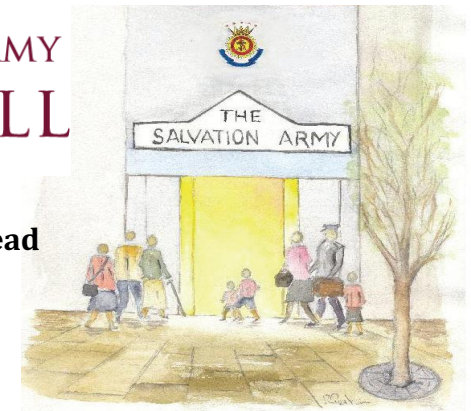

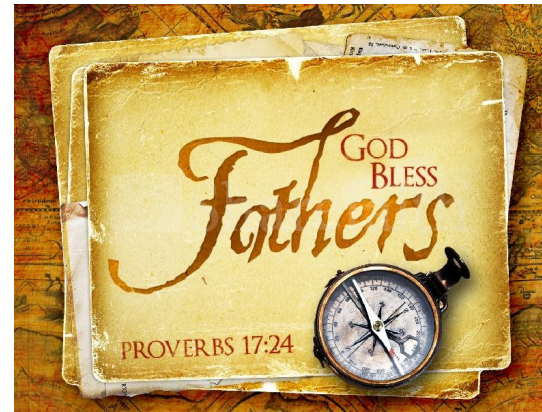
