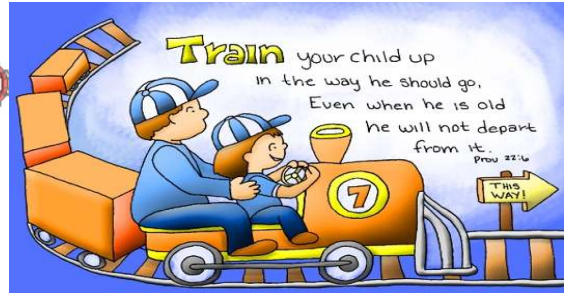

COLINS ICO BULLETIN:

"Hopefully, most of you will know that I will be attending the ICO in the near future. The ICO is the International College for Officers and is based in Sunbury Court, on the outskirts of London. The ICO exists to further develop officers by:

- *Nurturing personal holiness & spiritual leadership*
- *Fostering leader-development & capacity building current & future officer leaders*
- *Providing opportunity to experience the internationalism of the Salvation Army*
- *Encouraging a renewed sense of mission and purpose as an officer*

In the session that I am attending, there are 35 delegates from around the world with just 2 from the United Kingdom. This will be the 241st session or the 2 for 1 session - I'm obviously the free one. Because delegates come from around the world, each session is supported by a group of translators, and the language that they are supporting on this occasion is Russian. Each session lasts for 6 weeks and the dates I will be away will be from 10th April – 20th May (although we are taking some holiday the weekend before). We are given one free weekend during the six weeks, so I am hoping that it will be possible to bring a group to Staple Hill. If this is possible would you be able to look after one or two of them over a weekend? If you can, please let me know. I will miss Easter, which is disappointing, but Nicola has it all sorted, so it will be excellent (or eggcellent!!) If you would like to know any more information, please speak with me." COLIN
