The Weekly Bulletin for Sunday 15th December 2019

During December Colin & Nicola's preaching has considered **THE LIGHT:** *Christmas Light* (John 1:1-18), *Lighting the Darkness* (Isaiah 9:1-7), *Night Light* (Luke 2:8-20), *Star Light* (Matthew 2:1-12), *Light Dawns* (Luke 2:1-7) & *Light at Last* (Luke 2:25-35).

Some of the lights in our building are on up to 14 hours a day and we have focussed on replacing those high usage lights with LED units. In total 38 lights were changed. Whilst there has been an initial cost, we know that because they are more energy efficient and more reliable, over time they will pay for themselves in reduced energy bills and maintenance costs. This

saving is further helped in that 12 of the units have motion sensors and reduce to 10% light output when not in use. As a result of this work, we will reduce our carbon footprint and impact on the environment. See if you can see which lights have been changed – Colin has a prize for the first person to tell him where all 38 new lights are!


