During the past week, I have heard of the Promotion to Glory of a dear old man who, for more years than you could possibly imagine, served as Young People's Sergeant Major (YPSM) at Street corps; the number of children he helped to shape and influence over the decades, myself included, are beyond counting.

Whenever I think of Graham, I am reminded of the hymn tune 'Song of the highway' [see SASB 597], which seemed to be a favourite of his and one that he chose to use almost every week during Sunday School worship (but from the perspective of a 10 year-old cornet player, went on and on for ever!). That song talks about the pilgrim journey, and a very personal journey at that, through the joy, the battles and the triumphs of a life dedicated wholly to Jesus. Graham epitomised the song in every respect (see chorus below) – a true Christian to the end of his days. Even though frail in body for many years, his mind remained sharp. During my recuperation from heart surgery, Graham frequently phoned to see how I was and to assure me of his continuing prayers – and I must have been just one of hundreds that he continued to pray for. A faithful servant who gave his all fully to God.
