PLANS AS RESTRICTIONS EASE:

At the time of printing, we are still waiting for the Government Covid guidelines for Churches to be updated. Unless they include something unexpected, our plans for Church life after 19th July are as follows (despite restrictions easing we are committed to keeping everyone safe):

- **Sunday 25th July and 1st August:** Worship will continue as before. Everyone will be encouraged to wear face masks, ventilation will be good, chairs will be spaced out. But hopefully singing will be allowed! Meetings at 10am & 11.30am.
- **Remaining Sundays in August:** We will continue with two meeting times.
 - In the 10am meeting we will start to gradually increase the number of chairs but ensure extra space. If you do not want to sit next to anyone, we will have 'reserved' cards available for you to place on nearby chairs.
 - The 11.30am meeting will be quieter and less busy, chairs will remain spaced out.

Until at least the end of August, you will still need to book in and we strongly encourage people to wear face masks while in the building.
