Fathers' Day

Every time I think about Fathers' Day, the following hymn comes to mind:

This is my Father's World,
And to my listening ears
All nature sings and round me rings
The music of the spheres.

[The Song Book of The Salvation Army, No. 66]

Sung to the very simple tune Terra Beata (Blessed Earth), it speaks of the beauty of God's creation. It was from a poem written by Maltbie Davenport Babcock, a presbyterian minister, in around 1900 who used to enjoy walks and the spectacular scenery around the Great Lakes that border between America and Canada. Unfortunately, he died at the very young age of 42.

When reading the story behind this hymn and the man who wrote it, I was struck by a phrase reportedly used at Babcock's funeral "We do not need a candle to show a sunbeam... the life he lived speaks for him".

Today, as we honour our earthly fathers, most of us will probably give some thought to the lives that they have lived. How many can be likened to a sunbeam? What an aspiration for all us fathers to hold on to!

Jesus wants me for a sunbeam, to shine for Him each day.

After the meeting today there will be an opportunity to have a guided tour to explain exactly the work that is being undertaken. So if you are interested please take advantage of this.




