Last Sunday, I had the privilege of being part of a small group of musicians playing at Ashfield Prison to around 40 or 50 inmates. Although it was my first time there, I have previously played in the old Shepton Mallet prison through my time at Street corps. And listening to the conversations taking place around the band, I am guessing that between us we had been to almost a dozen different prisons through the various corps that we have been involved with. Multiply that up by all the Salvation Army bandsmen throughout the years, and you start to realise what sort of impact this type of ministry will have had.

I said that I had the privilege of doing this, and I really do mean it. The men attending the service sang with tremendous gusto, and were clearly hanging off every word that Hylton said – eagerly soaking up the truths contained within the Bible. These are people who have been incarcerated due to the mistakes they have made in life, and I am sure they all dream of the freedom that will come when their sentences are complete.

We all make mistakes. We all fail God. We all become prisoners to the sins we have committed, so we are no different from those inside the prison. But Jesus sets us free.

My chains fell off, my heart was free, I rose, went forth, and followed thee.
