At the end of the service and in complete silence, Colin slowly carried a body wrapped in a shroud representing the body of Jesus through the congregation

and placed it in the 'tomb' at the front of the hall. Nothing could have brought home the horror of the crucifixion more powerfully, nothing could have made the despair felt by Jesus' followers more real to us than we felt at that moment.
