Providing Gifts and Hampers for Families

We work in partnership with Social Services and other agencies to provide gifts and food hampers to children and their families. During Christmas 2022 we gave gifts to over 2000 people throughout South Gloucestershire & Bristol.

In our centre in Staple Hill, we host Christmas day for people who would otherwise be alone on this special day. We provide a traditional Christmas dinner, a family atmosphere with entertainment and a goody bag & gift to take home, all free of charge. 70 people shared the day with us in 2022.
